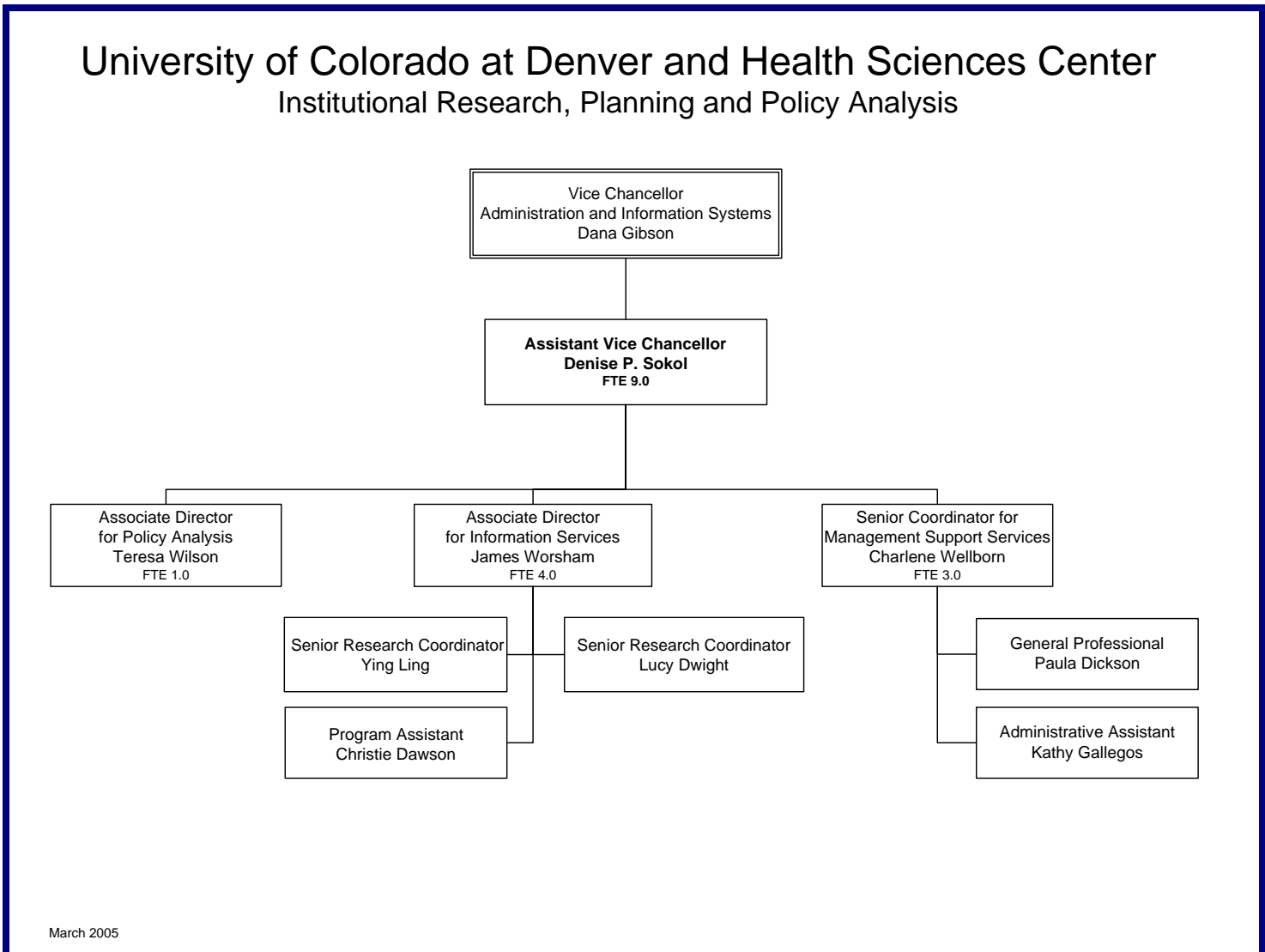

- CCIF, combined course information file with course, enrollment, and instructor data
- Census date and end of term enrollment files, source of official FTE reporting to the state
- The Common Data Set (CDS) collected by college-guide publishers
- Longitudinal files used for graduation rate reporting
- Faculty and staff employee files
- Data for external surveys (from college guidebooks, IPEDS, others, the press, internal inquiries)
- Data for peer institution comparisons

The office provides research and data support to entities throughout campus, including the Chancellor, Vice Chancellors and Deans, academic programs, student services units, administrative units, and student government. Additionally the office provides policy analysis in areas such as new ethnic-racial codes, tuition reform, instructor salaries, and admission standards as well as representation of UCDHSC to CCHE, CU System institutional researchers, other CU system-wide efforts, and state and national IR professional organizations.

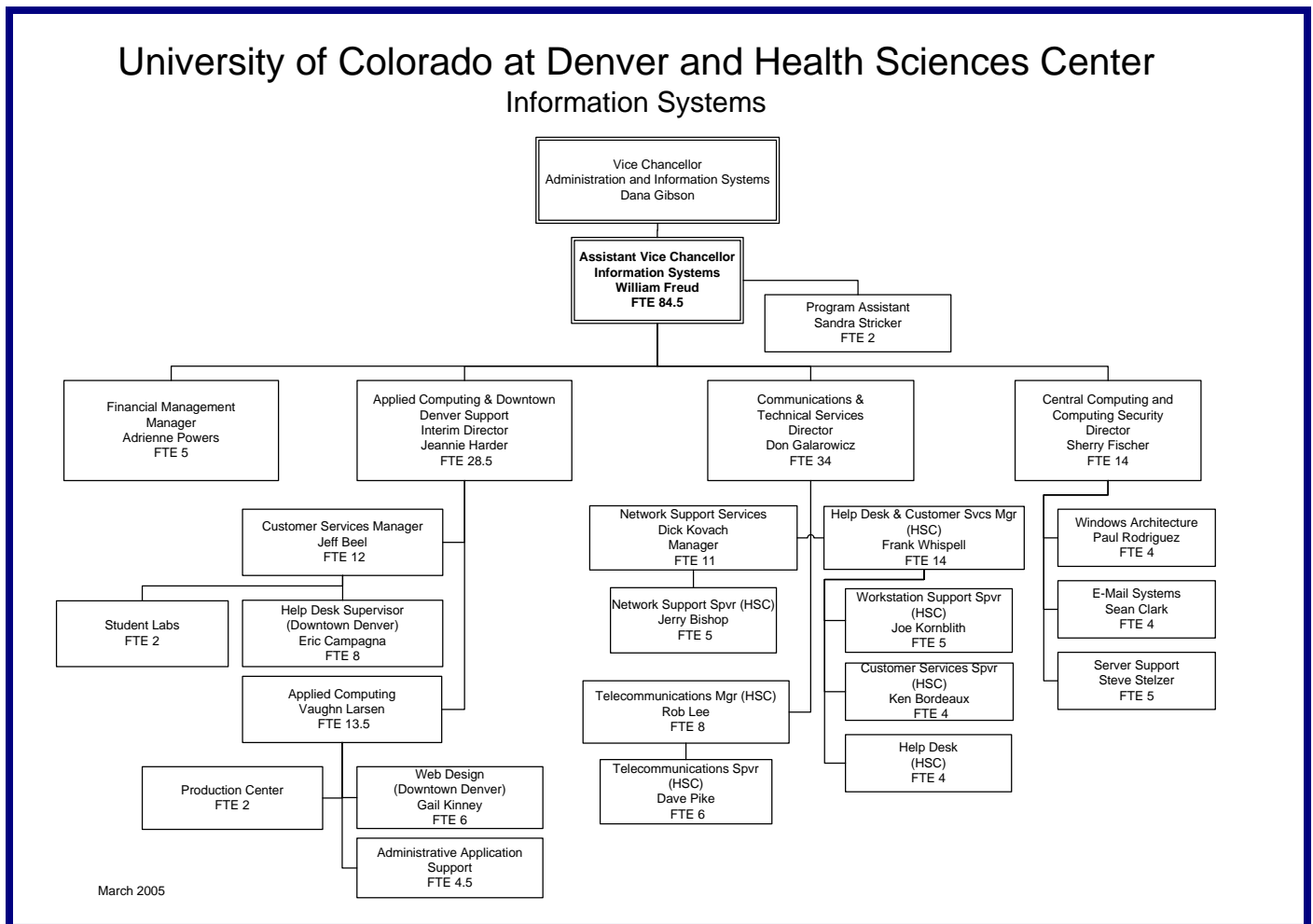


Information Systems

The UCHSC Information Systems Department and the CU Denver Computing, Information, and Network Services (CINS) organizations have consolidated management and integrated many of our operations. The new organization provides computing and communications support for the 9th and Colorado, Fitzsimons at Aurora, and downtown Denver campus locations. Our new UCDHSC Information Systems Department continues to offer walk-up customer service desks at each at each the three campus locations. To minimize the impact on our customers, our plan is to phase in the consolidation over the next several years. For the time being, the Downtown Denver Campus (DDC) Help Desk will support DDC customers, while the Fitzsimons Help Desk will support the Health Sciences campuses. The consolidation of our computing and data networking infrastructures will be a major undertaking. Probably our most daunting technical challenge will be to change our Internet domain. We have registered the www.ucdhsc.edu internet domain and have a web server advertising the UCDHSC consolidation web site. Over the next 12 -24 months, our plan is migrate all UCHSC and CU Denver computing resources into the new domain. This means that over the next two years all University e-mail addresses, web sites, and computer addresses will need to be changed. We will do our best to minimize any disruptions. We recognize that the consolidation of our two university infrastructures will create challenges for both ourselves and our customers and we look forward to working with you as we build our new great university.



Student Financial Services

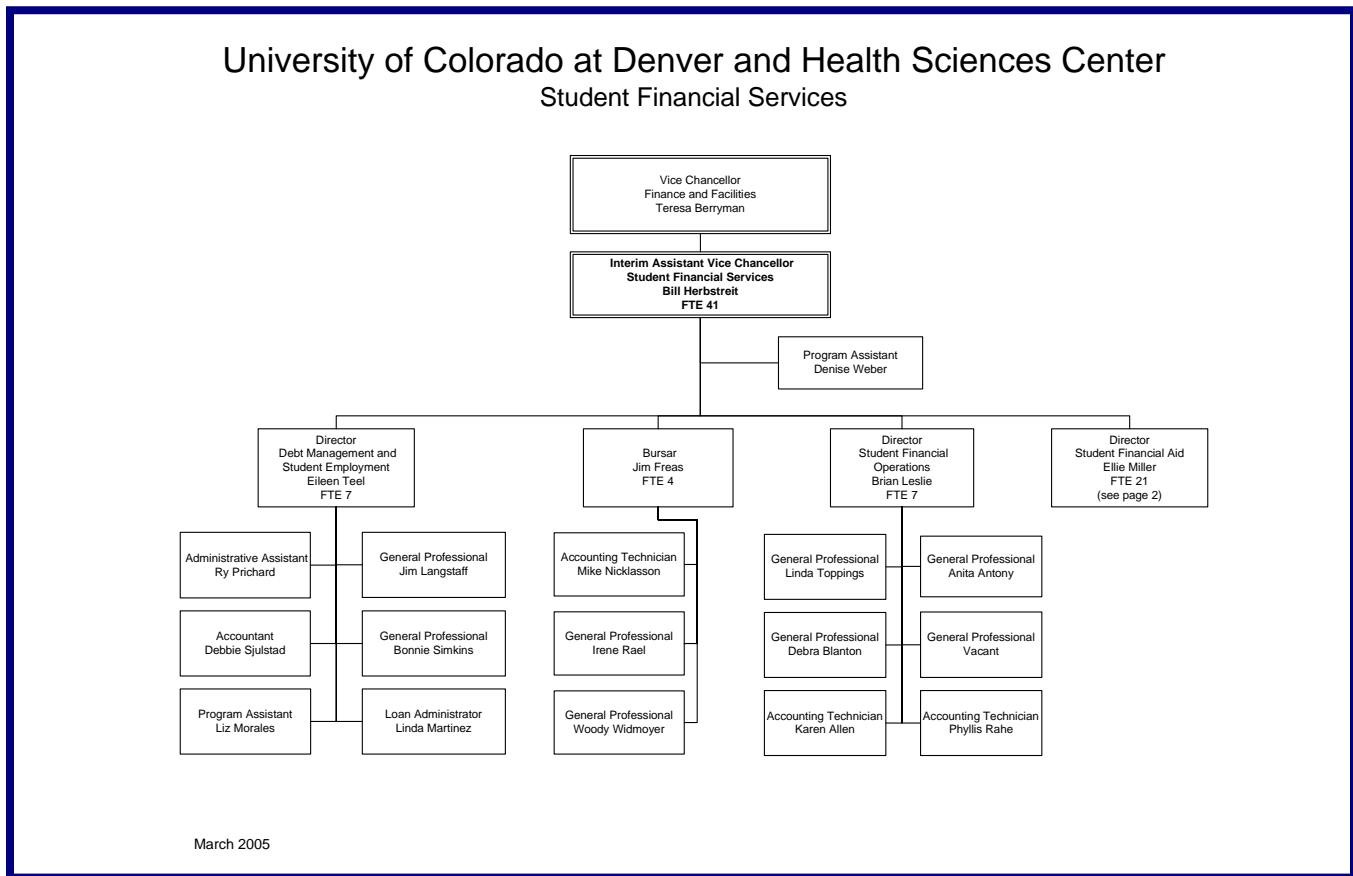
Student Financial Services for UCDHSC is made up of four departments: Financial Aid, Bursar, Student Financial Operations, and Debt Management and Student Employment.

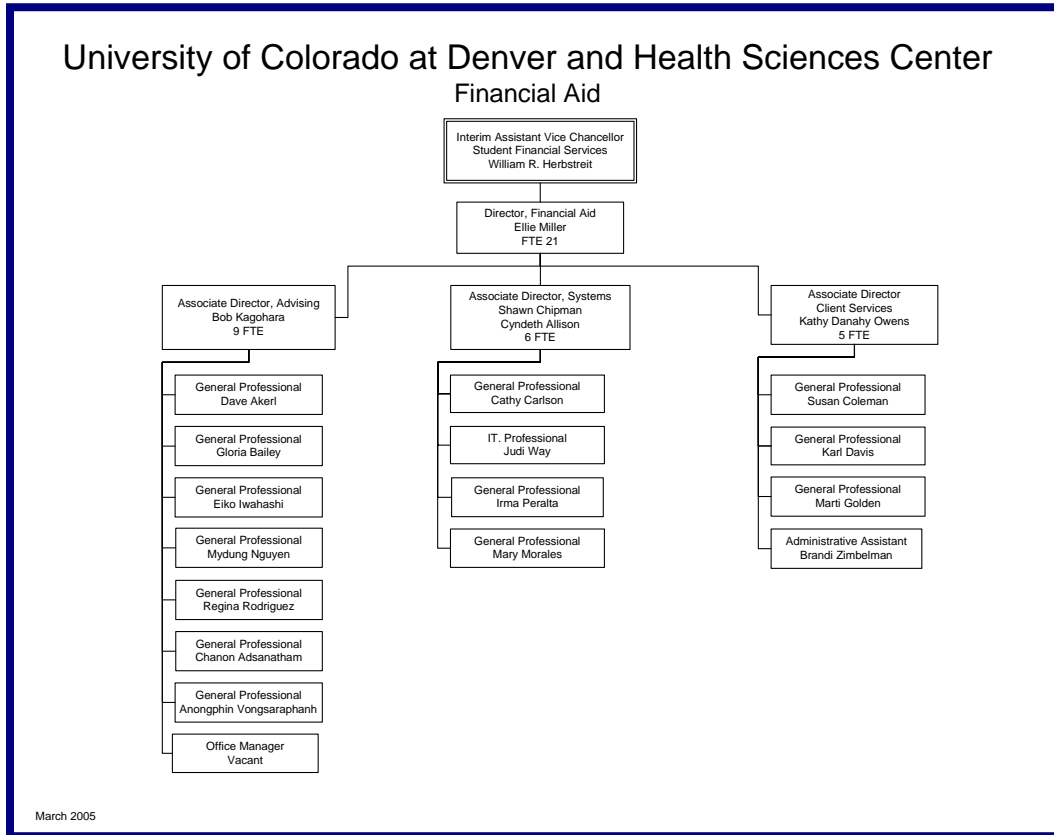
